

RESOLUTION NO. 18-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, DECLARING A VACANCY IN OFFICE FOR CITY TREASURER, DETERMINING TO FILL SUCH VACANCY BY APPOINTMENT, AND DIRECTING STAFF TO ADVERTISE THE VACANCY

WHEREAS, at the November 7, 2017 regular election, City Treasurer Gregg Fisher was elected to a position on the City Council for the City of Castle Pines ("City"); and

WHEREAS, there is a vacancy in office for the elective position of City Treasurer as of January 8, 2018 ("Vacancy Date"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with C.R.S. §§ 31-4-106 and 31-4-108(2)(b), the City Council must either appoint a person to fill the vacancy within sixty (60) days of the vacancy or schedule a special election; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to appoint a person to fill the vacancy in order to save time and the expense of conducting a special election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO THAT:


Section 1. The City Council hereby: (1) declares that as of January 8, 2018, there is a vacancy in the office of City Treasurer for the City of Castle Pines; (2) determines that it is appropriate to appoint a person to fill the vacancy in accordance with C.R.S. §§ 31-4-106 and 31-4-108(2)(b); and (3) directs City Staff to advertise said vacancy.


Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.
